Suggestions of Feedback Committee:

- It was observed that regarding the completion of syllabus on time by the teachers 96.31% students found it very good and good. The feedback committee suggested the authority to appeal all the teachers to cover the syllabus 100% within the stipulated time.
- It was observed that regarding the Library facilities 89.73% students found it very good and good. The Feedback Committee suggest that the college need to increase more books in the library to cope up with the CBCS curriculum.
- All total 95.48% student rated teachers very good and good regarding the use of ICT
 tools while teaching. The feedback committee suggested that the college should construct
 more ICT enabled classroom. The teachers should use more e-learning resources to
 impart quality education.
- 4. All total 62.75% alumni of the college regarded as the counselling and placement facility of the college is very good and good. More Counselling and placement programme need to be conducted. The counselling and placement cell should be more vibrant to cater the needs of students.
- Alumni Association need to be government registered. The committee suggest the alumni association to do the needful.
- 6. Boys' hostel needs to be constructed for the male students coming from distant areas.
- All total 69.93% students found the canteen facility as poor and very poor. Canteen facilities should be increased for the convenience of teachers and students.
- All total 67.73% students found the toilet facility as poor and very poor. Canteen facilities should be increased for the convenience of teachers and students.
- Sports facilities need to be improved. Indoor stadium should be constructed in the institution. More sports equipment need to be purchased.
- 10. As per student's feedback gymnasium facilities need to be improved.
- 11. It was observed that regarding the internet facility 83.98% students found it very good and good. The feedback committee suggested the authority to improve the facility.
- 12. The respective teachers should be encouraged to undertake innovative research projects. The feedback committee has provided a few suggestions to the administration of the college to implement these in the near future for overall development of academic ambience of the institute.


