Participants profile

Total 67 participants from and around the region is participated in the workshop. Among the 67 participants 35 participants came from various parts of Assam and 32 are in house participants. The participants are mainly Teaching Faculty, Library and Information Science Professional and Research Scholar of various disciplines.

Description about the program

The workshop started at 10.15 a.m. with a welcome address by Organizing Secretary Priyanka Bhuyan (Librarian i/c, Nanda Nath Saikia College, Titabar). The workshop was presided by the Patron of the workshop Dr. Litool Baruah (Chairperson of IQAC & Principal, Nanda Nath Saikia College, Titabar). He highlighted the importance of the workshop in the present informative World and knowledge society. He gave his sincere gratitude to Dr. Nazim Forid Islam, Convenor of the workshop and Coordinator of IQAC, Nanda Nath Saikia College, and to Priyanka Bhuyan, Organizing Secretary of the workshop for choosing such type of topic. Dr. Das had tremendously showcases the plagiarism issue in the context of copyright violation. The resource person stress out the burning issue and actual picture of degrading utility of research outcome among the researchers and academicians in India by statistically comparing it with other countries like USA, China etc. He mention about the predatory journals that how these type of journals increase the plagiarism tendency among the scholars knowingly and unknowingly. Dr. Das had shown various measures taken by library and information science professionals to deal with plagiarism and also the various program of MHRD, Govt. of India for eradicating plagiarism. Dr. Das had shown some practical demo of the application software Turintin, Urkund for detecting plagiarized content in an article and vice versa. He demonstrate these plagiarism checker for the participants. He also gave some name of free plagiarism detecting software available online for personal use.

After the second technical session, there held a small discussion between resource persons and the participants. The participants asked various question regarding the topic and their personal experiences.

The workshop concluded with valedictory ceremony and certificate distribution to the participants, anchored by the organizing secretary. Finally, the workshop ended in 2.30 p.m. with a vote of thanks given by Dr. Konnaki Konwar, Member of IQAC, Department of Economics, Nanda Nath Saikia College, Titabar.
