DISABLED FRIENDLY POLICY

The College is constantly putting conscious efforts to enrich the human resources by imparting quality education to the students and has also made due efforts for providing equity in access to higher education. The needs and problems of all people with disabilities, students and employees alike, must be recognized and addressed in order to motivate, unlock and fulfil their potential.

Policy Statement:

College is committed to "Divyanjan Kindness" among staff and students. Emphasis on taking necessary measures such as securing seats for people with disabilities, ramps, barrier-free entrances, barrier-free stairs including toilets, provision of facilities such as wheelchairs, provision of learning resources, and special measures during examinations is placed. By providing a hassle-free and accessible environment, specially abled students are able to pursue academic achievement on an equal footing with other students. The college provides academic, career and psychological guidance through its built-in mentor mentee system, career counselling to secure employment opportunities and prevent discrimination based on disability.
